Rewards and Consequences:

Campers will be recognized for good behavior and regularly receive verbal praises for good behavior.

If a camper chooses to break a rule, a course of action will be enforced. Should it be necessary, the following set of consequences is the guideline we will use to correct inappropriate behavior displayed at camp.

First Time: Verbal warning.

Second Time: Time out.

Third Time: Phone call to parent/guardian.

If a child continues to display inappropriate behavior, the child may be expelled. There is no refund.

Campers hours are 9:00 am – 4:00 pm. Early drop off begins at 7:30am and campers need to be picked up by 6:30pm. There is no additional charge for early drop off and late pick up. If you need to drop off before 7:30 or pick up after 6:30 it will need to be pre-arranged. The cost for this is \$5 per half hour (or part of a half hour)

The cost of Day Camp is \$125.

(Ask about discounts for multiple weeks or families of 3 or more children)

Additional Programs:

Swim Lessons: Your child participates in our swim lesson program. This includes 4 lessons (Monday-Thursday). **The additional cost of this program is \$40.**

Horse Camp: Your child participates in our horse camp program. Horse camp takes place from 9:00am-Noon. Horse campers receive a daily 45 minute riding lessons, hands on horsemanship classes, horse care classes and horse safety. We must have a signed liability release on file for your child to participate. Long pants and closed toe shoes are required. This program is only available for children ages 7 and older. **The additional cost of this program is \$100.**

Riding Lessons: Your child participates in riding lessons. This may be a single lesson, daily lesson (Monday-Thursday), or any combination of lessons. (We do not teach on Fridays). Lessons will be scheduled based on availability. We must have a signed liability release on file for your child to participate. Long pants and closed toe shoes are required. **The additional cost of this program is \$35 for a single lesson.** If you wish to participate in more than one lesson please contact Kimberly.
